

ARE YOUR PETS DETAILS up to date?



■ WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

Under the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998, all cats (born after 1 July 1999) and all dogs must be microchipped and lifetime registered by 12 weeks of age or at point of sale.

Once microchipped and registered, it is important to update Council with specific details throughout the life of your pet.

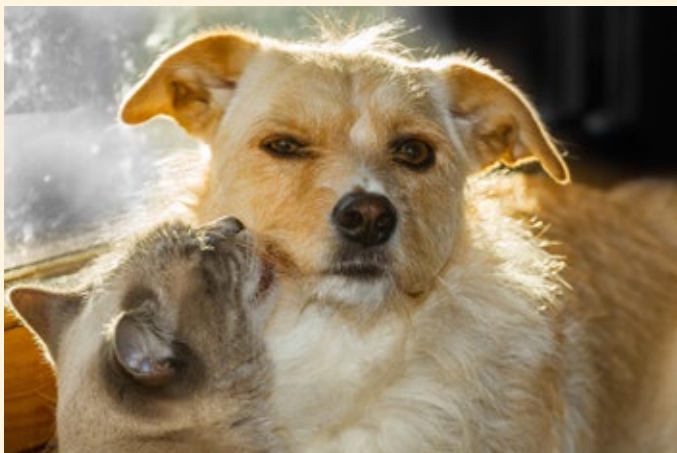
These include:

- If you change your contact details
- If you move address
- If you give away your pet
- If your pet passes away.
