

# Off-leash areas

Ku-ring-gai Council currently has 20 off-leash areas. These areas are a great way to exercise and socialise your dog, which can help reduce behavioural problems.

## Responsibilities while in an off-leash area:

- Ensure your dog is leashed to and from the area
- Keep your dog in sight at all times
- Be able to control your dog by voice
- Pick up and dispose of all waste correctly
- Ensure your dog does not rush at or harass other dogs and people

Our rangers regularly patrol these areas and the following fines will be issued for non-compliance:

<b>Not under effective control</b>	<b>\$220</b>
<b>Failure to pick up dog poo</b>	<b>\$275</b>
<b>Dog attack</b>	<b>\$550</b>
