

Scoop up the poop

Do you own a dog?

Do you always pick up your dog's waste?

Don't let your best friend spoil our streets - clean up after your dog and help keep our streets, footpaths, parks and reserves clean!

When walking your dog always carry bags or paper to pick up the poop. The owner or person walking the dog is responsible for picking up the poop and disposing of it in a bin.

Fine for failure to remove dog poo is \$275

Tip!

At off-leash areas keep your dog on a leash until your dog has pooped so you don't miss it!

Remember the four steps:



1 Always have your dog in sight



2 Use a bag or paper to pick up the poop



3 Tie the bag



4 Put the bag in the bin

Other responsibilities

- Always keep your dog on a leash in a public place unless you are in a designated off-leash area
- Ensure your dog has a collar and a name tag that has your name and a contact phone number
- Have your dog microchipped and lifetime registered.
