

Heydon Avenue, Warrawee/Woodville Avenue, Wahroonga Conservation Area C2 (KLEP 2015)

The Heydon Avenue Warrawee/Woodville Avenue Wahroonga Heritage Conservation Area is a distinctive residential area of historical and aesthetic significance for its fine Federation, Interwar and mid to late twentieth streetscapes, including Yosefa Avenue, which contains houses designed by architect Augustus Aley. The area contains a number of heritage items by notable architects including Redleaf and Inglewood, both designed by Howard Joseland. Significantly, the area retains its oldest house, Reaycroft at 17 Heydon Avenue, built in the Federation Queen Anne style in 1895 to a design by architects Castleton and Lake for Judge Heydon, after whom Heydon Avenue is named.
