BUSH RANGER RESERVE

Start & finish

Koola Park to Rocky Creek Track.

Distance

4.3km returning to Koola Park via the roads.

Difficulty

Moderate – steep, rough sections and steps. Contains 10m of unformed track and a mix of fire trail and single track.

Description

The track starts behind Koola Park, part of Bushranger Reserve. This descends for 65 metres leading to the start of Rocky Creek Track in the Garigal National Park with a distance of 320 metres.

Continue in an easterly direction to the end of the track. You will come out at the end of Koola Avenue East Killara for your return journey back to Koola Park, roughly a 4.3km walk.

The track crosses Hawkesbury Sandstone soils with outcrops of ironstone. Observe the vegetation community that has diverse native plant species. There are plenty of birds to hear and see along the way, particularly in early morning and evening.
